College & Dorm Storage Checklist

For semester breaks, study abroad, internships, and moves near colleges serving Bristol and Abingdon.

01 Inventory Decide what goes home, gets donated, or stays local.	02 Coordinate Share costs, access rules, and pickup dates with roommates.	03 Store Protect dorm essentials and keep next-semester items together.
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Before move-out

- ☐ Check residence hall deadlines, loading rules, and summer access dates.
- ☐ Confirm who can access the unit and whose name is on the rental.
- ☐ Measure mini-fridges, shelving, rugs, and boxed furniture.
- ☐ Back up school files and keep IDs, medication, and critical records with you.

Packing dorm items

- ☐ Defrost, clean, and fully dry mini-fridges before transport.
- ☐ Wash and dry bedding, towels, and clothing before sealing containers.
- ☐ Use plastic bins for items that will be reopened often and boxes for lighter long-term goods.
- ☐ Bundle cables, label chargers, and photograph electronic serial numbers.

Return-to-campus setup

- ☐ Store bedding, desk supplies, and first-night essentials together.

 - ☐ Schedule your pickup before peak move-in traffic when possible.
 - ☐ Update your inventory as roommates remove shared belongings.
