Four-Season Storage Checklist

A year-round reset plan for Southwest Virginia weather, household transitions, hobbies, and holiday storage.

SPR Spring Clean, dry, and rotate winter equipment and decor.	SUM Summer Prepare school, travel, patio, and recreation items.	FALL Fall/Winter Organize holiday, cold-weather, and storm supplies.
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Spring reset

- ☐ Clean and completely dry winter gear before packing.
- ☐ Rotate lawn, garden, sports, and outdoor equipment by access priority.
- ☐ Inspect boxes for damage and refresh inventory labels.
- ☐ Donate items that were not used during the previous year.

Summer transitions

- ☐ Plan storage for college moves, travel, renovations, and family transitions.
- ☐ Keep heat-sensitive belongings out of vehicles and unconditioned spaces.
- ☐ Store outdoor cushions and fabrics only after they are clean and dry.
- ☐ Create an easy-access zone for frequently used recreation items.
